

DID JESUS LIE?

Did Jesus Christ the Lord lie? Or did He just tell half the truth? Did the apostles, and all the authors of the Bible, divinely inspired by the Holy Spirit, lie, or just tell half the truth?

According to religious organizations and denominations today, Jesus either lied, or just told half the truth. All the authors of the Bible either lied, or just told half the truth.

And, since the Bible is the inspired Word of God, then God also lied, or just told half the truth. Therefore, according to our religions today, God the Father, God the Son, God the Holy Spirit. and the inspired Word, the Bible, is a lie.

John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

God does not hate the sinner. He loved the world, everybody, so much that He gave His only begotten Son, Jesus Christ, to die on the cross for the sins of all humanity. Then He said all we must do is believe in Him, Jesus Christ the Lord, and we have eternal life

The following is a list of some of the things man does and says that calls Christ and the Bible liars. We will attempt to avoid using names . However, it really is not necessary to use names

The Bible says that salvation is a free gift.

Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ, our Lord. (ref. John 4:10 Romans 5:15)

If salvation is a free gift, why do so many people claim we must do something? Either it is free by simple faith in the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ, or, according to these men, Christ lied.

The Bible says there is no work involved.

Ephesians 2:8,9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God--

Not of works, lest any man should boast.

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No one has the right to brag about what they did to acquire their salvation. It is a free gift and not

of mans works.

There are those who claim if you do not do something you are not really saved. If that were true then once again, Jesus Christ, the Bible, and the Holy Spirit, would be liars, and they are not.

When man inserts his own opinion into what the Bible says it is founded on self-righteousness and Bible ignorance, or, just plain Satanic delusion.

There are those who claim you must ask Jesus into your heart.
That statement is nowhere in the Bible, and calls Jesus Christ a liar.

There are those who claim you must make Jesus the Lord of your life.
That statement is nowhere in the Bible and calls Jesus Christ a liar. The fact is Jesus Christ the Lord is already the Lord. When you trust Him as your Savior, He is already the Lord.

Once again, self-righteousness, Bible ignorance, or, Satanic delusion.

There are those who claim that part of the salvation process includes walking down an aisle, coming to the mourners-bench, making an altar call, an altar of repentance, and so forth.
Of course, those statements are not in the Bible anywhere, and are manmade religious activities.
All of which are designed to call the Lord, Jesus Christ a liar.

There are those who claim you must repent of your sin and turn to God as part of the salvation process. Just simple faith in Christ as Savior is not enough they say. They claim the word repent used in the Bible means to turn from your sin and turn to God.
If that were true, then salvation would be founded on man's works (turning from sin is a work) and calls the Bible and the Holy Spirit liars.

The word repent used in the King James Bible is translated from two Greek words. They are, *metanoeo*, and *metanoia*.
Both words mean to change the mind. They have different endings because one is a verb and the other is a noun. Nouns and verbs have different endings in the Greek.
They both mean to change the mind. Change your mind about sin, who Christ was, what He did for us, eternity, my condition, and so forth. CHANGING THE MIND AND FAITH IN CHRIST ARE TWO SIDES OF THE SAME COIN.

There are those who say you must be water baptized to be saved. Faith in the finished work of Christ is just not good enough they say. Once again, we must add our own works to the simple gospel..
When we trust Christ as our Savior, we are instantly baptized with the Holy Spirit. Water baptism is our outward expression that we acknowledge our salvation.

There are those who say you must confess your sins to some man. Or you can pray to a so called saint. Or, you may ask Mary the mother of Jesus to intercede on your behalf.
John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life; no man cometh unto the

1 Timothy 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and man, the man, Christ Jesus.

Acts 3:16 And his name, through faith in his name, hath made this man strong.....

Acts 4:12 Neither is there salvation in any other; for there is no other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

Faith in Jesus Christ is the only way to God the Father. He is the one who hears. He is the one who forgives. He is the one who saves.

Jesus Christ is the one who came down from heaven, lived for thirty three years, died on the cross, was buried, and rose again, for the forgiveness of sin.

There are those who claim to have the full gospel.

The words full gospel are never used in the Bible. It is just one more lie from the Bible ignorant. The term is used by those who would like to condone their anti-bible religious acts. They claim that they have a more spiritual attitude than others because they have the 'full gospel.'

John 6:47 Verily, verily, I say unto, He that believeth on me hath everlasting life..
