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Introduction

God created Satan, the angels, and humanity, with a free will. That is, the ability to accept the God of the Bible, or reject Him.

When Satan and one third of the angels rebelled against God, they were cast out of the third heaven, the realm of God. (ref. Revelation 12:3,4 with Luke 10:18)

When they were, the original creation became dark and void. (Genesis 1:2a)

Then, God brought the earth back into original condition, (Genesis 1:2b) and created man and woman. (Genesis 1:26,27)

Satan always wanted to rule as God. (ref. Isaiah 14:12-17)

God has given Satan the ability to rule this earth through his demonic influence.

Satan only has the authority God allows him to have. Almighty God is still the boss.

The interaction between Satan and mankind began in the garden when Satan enticed Adam and Eve to disobey the command of God. (Genesis 3:1-6)

It all began with the four little words of Satan, "Yea hath God said?" (Gen. 3:1)

Nothing has changed in all these millenniums. The antichrist mentality will always say, "yea hath God said?."

The Bible Says

The Bible states it is the Word of the Lord and the truth. (Psalm 138:2 John 17:17)

The Bible states that Jesus Christ is the Word, and God manifest in the flesh. (John 1:1,2,14 1 Timothy 3:16 1 John 1:1,2 5:7)

Is this true? The antichrist mentality denies and rejects the Bible. The only thing the antichrist mentality agrees with is.....

Well... the antichrist mentality.

The Bible believing Christian may never prove the Bible is God's Word and the truth to the antichrist mentality, but we can prove it to ourselves with four historical facts.

Fact #1 The Hebrew Bible, (TANAKH) what we call the Old Testament, was divinely inspired between 1400 and 400 B.C.

The book of Malachi being the last Old Testament book.

Fact #2 The entire Hebrew Bible was translated into the Greek language by 100 B.C., at the request of Alexander the Great.

Alexander fulfilled the prophecy of Daniel in his lifetime. When he realized this, being told by a Jewish priest, he requested his generals to translate the Old Testament into Greek.

Ptolemy, one of his generals had the translation done by seventy scholars.

This translation was called the Septuagint.

Unfortunately, Alexander died in 323 B.C. at the age of 33, before he could see the translation completed.

Fact #3 Jesus Christ was a literal historic figure. It is recorded in all the history books, including, John C. Ridpath, H.G. Wells, The Jewish historian Josephus, and even our Encyclopedias.

Ironically, even the Koran records that Jesus was a real person, even though they deny He was God in the flesh, and the Savior of the World.

Fact #4 Archaeology has proven that the historical records listed in the Bible are accurate. Remains of Sodom and Gomorrah have been uncovered, along with relics from Ur of the Chaldeans, which many denied existed.

Also weapons of war have been discovered at the bottom of the Red Sea.

and that Jesus Christ fulfilled some 300 Old Testament prophecies concerning His birth, life, death, burial, and resurrection, He must be God, and His Word must be true.

Therefore, we may be assured, that Jesus Christ is God, and that He died, was buried, and rose again, for the forgiveness of sin.

All we have to do is believe He did this for our sin, and we have forgiveness of sin, and eternal life. (John 3:15,16 6:47 and many more)

The word antichrist is only used in 1 John 2:18,22 4:3 and 2 John 7.

It means against, or, opposition to, Christ. It is used to describe the man who will rule during the seven year tribulation. He is also called the man of sin, the son of perdition, and the beast.

However, John also states that there are many antichrist's.

The antichrist mentality has always existed. Everything God stands for, the antichrist mentality is against.

In Matthew, Mark, and Luke, the Bible records Jesus being tested in the wilderness by the Devil. (Satan)

The Devil showed Jesus "all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them." (ref. Matthew 4:8 Luke 4:5)

an high mountain, showed unto him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time.

And the devil said unto him, All this power will I give thee, and the glory of them; for that is delivered unto me, and to whomsoever I will I give it.

Once again, Satan told only half the truth. He had power to rule kingdoms; but only allowed by God.

Satan, the old devil, was actually arrogant enough to offer the world to the One who created and owned it. GOD Himself.

Satan's first attempt to create his kingdom was in the days of Noah. His angels indwelt humanity and created an entire population of antichrist's. Therefore, because of all the evil, God brought the flood. (Genesis 6:1-7)

All of humanity, except Noah and his family perished in the deluge, and man must begin to repopulate the earth.

Satan is not through however, and at Babel, he establishes another kingdom under Nimrod.

Instead of a flood, God confounded their language and dispersed man through the earth.

Remember, God told Noah to replenish the earth. (Genesis 9:1) Man said, no, we will stay at Babel. (Genesis 11:1-9)

NOTE: Man has been babbling ever since.

Land Of Shinar

Genesis 10:8-10 And Cush begot Nimrod: he began to be a mighty one in the earth.

He was a mighty hunter before the Lord: Wherefore it is said, Even as Nimrod the mighty hunter before the Lord.

And the beginning of his kingdom was Babel, and Erech, and Accad, and Calneh, in the land of Shinar.

In this short booklet we must be brief, yet

informative.

The beginning of Nimrod's kingdom was in the land of Shinar. The land of Shinar became a perfect model for the future kingdoms of Satan.

Nimrod was considered a god. His wife Semiramis was considered a goddess.

The traditional myth associated with Nimrod and his wife was that they had a son named Tamuz, who was killed by a wild boar, and had a miraculous resurrection.
(this is a brief account)

Therefore, we have the antichrist adaptation of the father, the mother, the son, and the miraculous resurrection.

Out of the land of Shinar came many kingdoms, such as Assyria, Chaldea, Babylon, which is present day Iraq.

Every one of these kingdoms mixed politics with religion. Often their kings were considered gods.

Egypt had a multitude of gods. The Pharaoh's often were named after their god's

Nebuchadnezzar was named after the Babylonian god nebo.

By mixing religious idols with political leaders, such as kings, queens, dictators, etc., Satan receives a kingdom against God, a worldly kingdom, that is antichrist in it's ideology.

The Prince of This World

In the Old Testament Satan is referred to as...

The Assyrian... Isaiah 10:24 14:25

King of Tyre... Ezekiel 28:12

Prince of the kingdom of Persia... Daniel 10:13

Prince that shall come... Daniel 9:26

The word prince simply means ruler.

In the New Testament he is referred to by Jesus Christ as....

The prince of this world...John 12:31 14:30
16:11

The god of this age...2 Corinthians 4:4

The prince of the power of the
air...Ephesians 2:2

The Antichrist Mentality And the Secular Community

Through the influence of Satan and his fallen angels the secular community rejects the Word of God.

The Bible says in the beginning God created. (Genesis 1:1 with John 1:1-4 Hebrews 1:1,2)

Our schools and institutions of higher learning say that is not true. They claim man began as a blob and evolved into what we see today.

If that were true, and it is not, evolution did not accomplish much.

The Bible says "be fruitful and multiply and replenish the earth." (Genesis 1:28 and 9:1 have children)

The Bible also says children are a gift of God, (Gen. 33:5) and a reward, and a heritage. (Psalm 127:3-5)

The antichrist mentality denies this and states abortion is a right.

The Bible states marriage is between a man and woman. (Genesis 1:26-24)

Two men together, or two women together cannot be fruitful and multiply. Even nature tells us that is just not logical.

The Bible states that homosexual acts are an abomination. (Leviticus 18:21-27 and 20:13)

The antichrist mentality seems to think the Ten Commandments are ten suggestions, or ten punishments. Therefore, they must be removed from society.

Tolerant and Diverse

The antichrist mentality claims it is tolerant and diverse, and goes to great lengths to prove it.

The idea simply implies that we accept and love any thought, race, lifestyle, and etc.

That's a noble idea but the antichrist mentality is tolerant of everything but the truth, the Bible, the Cross, the Ten Commandments and the Christian.

The antichrist mentality even defends the radical terrorist who kills everyone including their own; and all in the name of tolerance and diversity.

If one disagrees with the antichrist mentality, and defends his or her belief, the antichrist mentality will attack with all vigor.

Apparently the antichrist mentality seems to think God is intolerant.

After all, all these restrictions!

Everything God says in the Bible that is righteous and moral, the antichrist mentality is against.

The Antichrist Mentality And The Religious Community

What the Bible says.....

The Bible says all men are sinners. (ref. Romans 3:10,23)

The Bible says the wages of sin is death. (Romans 6:23)

The Bible says Christ died, was buried, and rose again, for the forgiveness of sin. (ref. 1 Corinthians 15:1-4 Acts 10:34-43 Acts 13:28-39)

The Bible says faith in the finished work of Christ is what pays for our sin and guarantees eternal life. (John 3:15,16 6:47 Ephesians 1:10-14)

The Religious antichrist mentality says that is not true, or not enough, and calls Christ and the Bible a lie.

Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves.

2 Corinthians 4:3,4 But if our gospel be hidden it is hidden to them that are lost.

In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them that believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.

2 Corinthians 11:13-15 For such are false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ.

And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.

Therefore, it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness, whose end shall be according to their works.

The antichrist mentality is busy in the religious community. Humanity is incurably religious and easily led astray.

Our man made denominations refuse to believe that salvation and eternal life is by faith in Jesus Christ plus nothing.

We are told we must do something, say something, feel something. We must show some proof to a man or a denomination that we are saved.

The religious leaders dress in their robes and wear large crosses around their neck.

Outwardly they look like sheep. Inwardly, if they do not have the simple gospel, they are ravenous wolves.

The Kingdom of God

What and Where is the Kingdom of God

The simple answer is that the kingdom of God is everything God has to offer, and is everywhere at all times, and is always available.

We are reminded in the book of Daniel that God rules in the kingdom of men and gives it to whosoever He wishes. (Daniel 4:17,25,32 5:18,21)

And His “dominion is an everlasting dominion, and his kingdom is from generation to generation.” (Daniel 4:34b)

In Deuteronomy 28:1-14 God told Israel of all the blessings they would receive if they served Him, and the curse if they did not in verses 28:25-68.

All of this was from the kingdom of God, who rules in the kingdoms of men.

John 3:3 Jesus answered, and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

The word see in this verse is from the Greek word *eido*, and it means, *to know; behold; be aware of... ..*

John 3:5 Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

The words enter into in this verse is translated from the Greek word, *eiserchomai*, and it means, *to come into*.

In other words, the born again child of God, who puts their faith in Christ as their Savior, has the ability to see the kingdom of God, and enter into it.

Or, receive the blessings God has to offer in this present life on earth.

Romans 14:17,18 For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink, but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.

For he that in these things serveth Christ is acceptable to God, and approved of men.

Just as Israel in the Old Testament could have been blessed by God if they served Him, so to, the New Testament Christian has the blessings from God's kingdom available, if they serve Him.

In 1 Corinthians 6:9-11 and Galatians 5:16-26 Paul warns the Christian concerning the kingdom of God.

He states that if we are not living a life that reflects Christ and produces fruit, we shall not "inherit the kingdom of God."

This does not mean eternal life. The word inherit in the Greek is *kleronomeo*, and it means, *to share by allotment; to obtain; receive.*

To receive our share of the allotment.

As we view the world around us, most people see the glory of the worldly kingdoms.

The Christian however, should see the kingdom of God.

In 1 Chronicles 29:1- Israel took up a collection to build the temple of God. After the collection the people rejoiced because they gave willingly to the Lord. (vs. 9)

1 Chronicles 29:10-12a Wherefore, David blessed the Lord before all the congregation: and David said, Blessed be thou Lord God of Israel, our father, forever and ever.

Thine, O Lord, is the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory, and the majesty; for all that is in the heaven and in the earth is thine. Thine is the kingdom, O Lord, and thou art exalted as head above all.

Both riches and honor come of thee, and thou reignest over all;

The earth and everything in it and those who dwell in it are the Lord's. (Psalm 24:1 89:11)

He is king over all the earth. (Psalm 47:7 68:22 83:18)

His kingdom rules over all. (Psalm 67:46 103:19)

The Big Question

The question everyone should be asking is.... If God rules in the kingdoms of men, and over all the earth, why is there so much evil and antichrist ideology?

We began this booklet with the answer. It is called free will. God does need to be trusted and worshipped by puppets. He gives humanity the ability to make decisions.

He has given us the ability to see Him in the very creation itself.

Then He fulfilled Old Testament prophecy concerning Himself; Jesus Christ the Lord.

In the presidential election of 2008 and 2012 the political parties ran on a platform of women's and gay rights.

Paul stated that a person must work for their needs and their families needs. (1 Corinthian 4:12 Ephesians 4:28 1 Thessalonians 4:11 2 Thessalonians 3:10-12)

After Israel finally entered into the promised land, they were ruled by Judges.

A judge was a mediator between the Lord and the nation of Israel.

The last judge was Samuel, because, in 1 Samuel chapter eight Israel requested a man to be their king.

Israel no longer wanted to be ruled by the Lord their God. (1 Samuel 8:4-18)

When the nation of Israel allowed God to govern them through their judges, they prospered and were blessed.

Today, Israel is scattered throughout the entire world, and long for their kingdom.

Unfortunately, when their real King, Jesus Christ the Lord, arrived on the scene, they rejected Him, and had Him nailed to a cross by the Romans.
